THE WILDLIFE (CONSERVATION AND MANAGEMENT) ACT

(2013)

(No. 47 of 2013)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by Section 116 of the Wildlife (Conservation and Management) Act, 2013 the Cabinet Secretary for Tourism, Wildlife and Heritage makes the following regulations:—

THE WILDLIFE (CONSERVATION AND MANAGEMENT) NATIONAL PARKS, RESERVES AND SANCTUARIES REGULATIONS, 2023

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Wildlife (Conservation and Management) (National Parks, Reserves and Sanctuaries) Regulations 2023 and shall apply from September, 2023 to 30th August 2025.
- 2. In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires-

CONSERVATION FEES" refers to fees charged in National Parks, Reserves and Sanctuaries for the purpose of conserving and protecting natural resources, such as wildlife, habitats and ecosystems.

KENYAN (KE) CITIZEN" refers to Kenyan nationals by birth and registration, with valid Identification Card.

"EAST AFRICA (EA) CITIZEN" refers to nationals of East Africa countries of Kenya, Uganda, Tanzania, Rwanda, South Sudan, Burundi and Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) with valid passport.

"RESIDENT" refers to persons of other nationalities residing in Kenya with valid documentation from the Kenyan government

"REST OF AFRICA" refers to nationals of African Countries other than East Africa Countries with valid passport.

"INTERNATIONAL (INTL) VISITORS/ NON RESIDENTS" refers to foreign nationals other than EAC and rest of Africa with valid passport.

"DAILY FEE" is a single entry fee valid for a day stay of continuous uninterrupted stay inside a KWS National Park/Reserve/ Sanctuary.

"STUDENT" refers to an individual from a recognized secondary, government or private college or university aged up to twenty-three (23) years old visiting the parks for purposes of learning about conservation through a documented and organized arrangement with that institution. It excludes students on personally arranged holidays. KWS will require a minimum of one (1) week to issue a written authorization for the student rates.

"CHILDREN" refers to persons from the age of five (5) years but below the age of eighteen (18) years. Children below age of 5 years access the KWS Parks, Reserves and Sanctuaries for free.

- "PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES (PWD)" refers to Kenyan Citizens who have a physical, sensory, mental or other impairment, including any visual, hearing, learning or physical incapability, which impacts adversely on social, economic or environmental participation. PWD access all KWS parks and reserves for free upon presentation of valid documentation from the National Council for Persons with Disabilities.
- "SENIOR CITIZEN" refers to Kenyan Citizens aged 70 years and above. Senior Citizens will enjoy free entry to all KWS Parks and Reserves upon presentation of the national ID.
- "ANNUAL PASS" is fees paid once to access KWS parks, reserves and sanctuaries for a year.
- "WATER SPORTS" refers to any recreational/sports activities that takes place in or on water and can be categorized according to the degree of immersion.
- "SECURITY", refers to the safety provided by KWS Rangers to Visitors. Security fee for one Section of rangers (10 Rangers) shall be applicable to event sites after 6.30pm.
- "CORPORATE PASS" refers to access rights issued to eligible utility providers having installations within KWS managed parks/reserves
- "HIGH SEASON" shall be from 1st July to 31st March
- "LOW SEASON" shall be from of 1st April to 30th June
- MT. KENYA "HIGH SEASON" shall be 1st July to 30th September, and 1st December to 29th February.
- MT. KENYA "LOW SEASON" shall be 1st October to 30^{th} November and 1st March to 30^{th} June.
- *All other parks and reserves include; Marsabit, Mwea, Ruma, Saiwa Swamp, South Turkana, Sibiloi, Central Island, South Island, Kakamega, Shimba Hills, Ndere Island, Malka Mari, Tana River Primates, Nasolot, Chyullu Hills and Lake Elementaita Wildlife Sanctuary.
- *Mt Kenya Packages include camping fees;
- *Special activity fees do not include Park, Reserve or Sanctuary entry fees.
